SCHEDULED STAGE PERFORMERS

For Musicians, Singers, Musical Groups, Dancers, and other Stage Performers

*All Main Stage Performances take place in the Elks Hall in Didsbury.
Secondary stage locations are at Vintage Coffee House and at the Didsbury Museum.*

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. All applications will be screened. The Mountain View Arts Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse any application deemed to be inappropriate. Preference will be given to local performers first as well as smaller, acoustic style groups (no more than 4 performers).
2. Registration (application) does not confirm a place in the schedule. Performers will be notified by e-mail on their confirmation as soon as possible. Exact days and times in the scheduling will be confirmed by the end of July. No guarantee on times.
3. All Performers (Main or Secondary Stages) must make available at least three (3) digital photographs. If requested, they must also submit audio examples to the Performer Coordinator.
4. By submitting the application form you consent to the use of your name and application image(s) in the Festival program as well as in other media to help promote the Festival.
5. By submitting the application form you hereby give the Mountain View Arts Festival Committee unrestricted right to use all photos taken on behalf of the Mountain View Arts Festival at the Festival itself in whatever manner deemed appropriate by the Mountain View Arts Festival Committee in the promotion of the Festival.
6. Deadline for applications is 6 pm, Sunday, July 15, 2018.

FEE SCHEDULE

7. Performers will be paid a flat rate of \$100 or \$150 (Solo or Group) at the end of their performance(s), based on 30, or 45 minute set lengths. Set length at the Main Stage location is 45 minutes; set length at secondary locations is 30 minutes.

SOUND AND LIGHTING

8. Sound and lighting at Main Stage location to be provided by Mountain View Arts Festival. Performers agree to use the sound system provided. Performers are expected to bring their own instrument cables.

9. Secondary Stage locations will be "acoustic". There will be no PA provided and performers should be solo or duo acts with instruments that can be played "unplugged", or performance art which requires no amplification.

INSURANCE & RESPONSIBILITIES

10. It is the responsibility of the Performer to have and maintain adequate liability insurance coverage.
11. The Mountain View Arts Festival Committee, Town of Didsbury, Mountain View County, Didsbury Elks Lodge, associated businesses and individuals, staff and volunteers cannot be held responsible for injuries, damages or losses to participants or their goods.
12. The Mountain View Arts Festival Committee, Town of Didsbury, Mountain View County, Didsbury Elks Lodge, associated businesses and individuals, staff and volunteers cannot be held responsible for any lost or stolen items before, during or after the Festival.

DATE, TIMES, AND SITE ACCESS

13. Date: September 8, 2018
Times: 11:00 am - 5:00 pm
14. Main Stage Performers must arrive at the Didsbury Elks Hall (1914 - 20 St) at least 30 minutes before their scheduled performance. Load in instructions will be provided to Main Stage performers prior to the Festival.
15. Secondary Stage Performers must arrive at the designated location at least 15 minutes before their scheduled performance. Please check in with the Stage Manager following your performance to receive your fee.
16. A Green Room will be provided for Main Stage Performers in the Didsbury Elks Hall. Please check in with the Performer Coordinator upon arrival.

NO SHOW POLICY

17. Any performer who does not show up, regardless of cause, will NOT be paid nor be invited back.
